You can be instrumental in changing lives like Munni Akhter's. At 9 years old, Munni lost her mother to COVID-19, and just a year later, her father passed away from a stroke.

Can you imagine unexpectedly losing both of your parents, your foundation, at such a young age? For Munni, it was devastating.

After Munni's parents passed away, **she lived without access to the most basic necessities and education.** Munni shared, "School was very far from my home, so I couldn't go regularly." She also had to drink and bathe in dirty water from a nearby pond, the only available source of water.

Without enough food to eat, clean water to drink, or an education, it is unlikely Munni could have ever escaped extreme poverty.

becoming a doctor. She recently voiced, “I deeply pray for For Kids’ Sake International supporters and those that work day and night to provide us with everything we need.” Munni knows the transformation in her life wouldn’t be possible without you.

Now is the time to act. In addition to supporting 550 orphans and 4,000 students, nearly all of the FKSI orphanage buildings must be replaced to guarantee the kids’ safety. These buildings were built more than 40 years ago, and the concrete is crumbling rapidly due to the harsh conditions in Bangladesh.

This need is imminent and unprecedented. It will take \$500,000 to fully support FKSI facilities and allow construction of new orphanage buildings to begin. Just \$245,000 must be raised by year-end to make this possible.
